Greetings everyone. Welcome to the 2025-2026 U11 Female Hockey season with Lloydminster Minor Hockey. I (Steven Gehlen) am the director of your division. My email is

There will be three, possibly four U11 blazers teams. These teams will play in the U11 mainstream city league. Evaluations will start on September 20th. We will have three groups for the evaluations. One group will be split up for the skills session as there are only two skills sessions.

We only have two full time goalies. If your child wouldn't mind playing goal part time please let me know. We will have to build 2 teams with part time goalies. Parents keep in mind that LMHA will provide the major components of the goalie gear to keep the burden to a minimum. If she is on the fence about it let me know. Then we can put some of these girls on the same team and they can work together.

This is a very busy time for LMHA as U11, U13 and U15 evaluations all take place on the same weekend. Outside evaluators are evaluating the kids and the program for the weekend is determined by the evaluators. There will be three ice times. A skills session and two scrimmages. There will also be a goalie session that is co-ed.

These evaluations will require volunteers. We will need someone to hand out jerseys and check the kids in, a few volunteers to run the skills session, the scrimmages will require bench staff, and we will need one parent from each evaluation team to take home the jerseys and wash them. After the evaluations we will have at least one confirmation skate. Because we are short on ice surfaces this may be the following weekend after evaluations. This time has yet to be determined. After the confirmation skate, the teams will be finalized.

For the upcoming season we need coaches, managers and helpers. Please refer to the Hockey Alberta website for the required coaching certificates. Also, parents are to take their respect in sport through Hockey Canada prior to the start of the season. Please check that you are current as

they do expire. Coaches will be required to provide their background checks and current certifications. If these items are not provided your child will not be permitted to attend.
